

D-ring belts are fashionable and easy to make. It only takes a few minutes with just 5 easy steps and you can make these belts in a rainbow of colors - even metallic!



1. Gather your supplies:

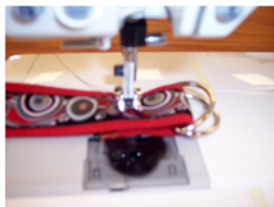
- Enough webbing (1 ¼" wide) to go around your waist plus 6 to 8 inches extra.
- 7/8 to 1" wide ribbon (*same amount as the webbing*).
- 2 - 1 ¼" belt tips.
- 2 - 1 ¼" rings.



2. Stitch ribbon onto the webbing.



3. Clamp a belt tip onto both ends of the belt.



4. Slide 2 d-rings onto one end of belt and stitch securely.



5. Loop the belt end through the d-rings and enjoy!

For this project I have opted to make a ribbon and webbing belt. Ribbon is optional. If you wish to embroider the ribbon, I prefer to do it before I stitch the ribbon to the webbing. Please note: you will need to put ribbon on both sides of your webbing.
